

HOLY WEEK

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Maundy Thursday is the day during Holy Week that commemorates Jesus' washing of the disciples' feet and His last supper with them on the night before His crucifixion. The word "Maundy" comes from the Latin word "mandatum," which means "commandment." This night is referred to as "Maundy Thursday" because this was the night, according to the Gospel of John, when Jesus gave His disciples a new commandment to love one another as He had loved them. (John 13:34).

GOOD FRIDAY

Good Friday is the day during Holy Week when Jesus was crucified between the hours of noon and 3 pm. On this day, set aside some time to reflect again on the events that led up to, and took place on, Good Friday by reading the Gospel accounts found in Matthew 26-27, Mark 14-15, Luke 22-23, and John 13-9. We are not ready to celebrate the joy of Easter Day until we have first experienced the agony of Good Friday.

HOLY SATURDAY

Holy Saturday is the day during Holy Week between Good Friday and Easter Day, the Jewish Sabbath, a day of silence and stillness.

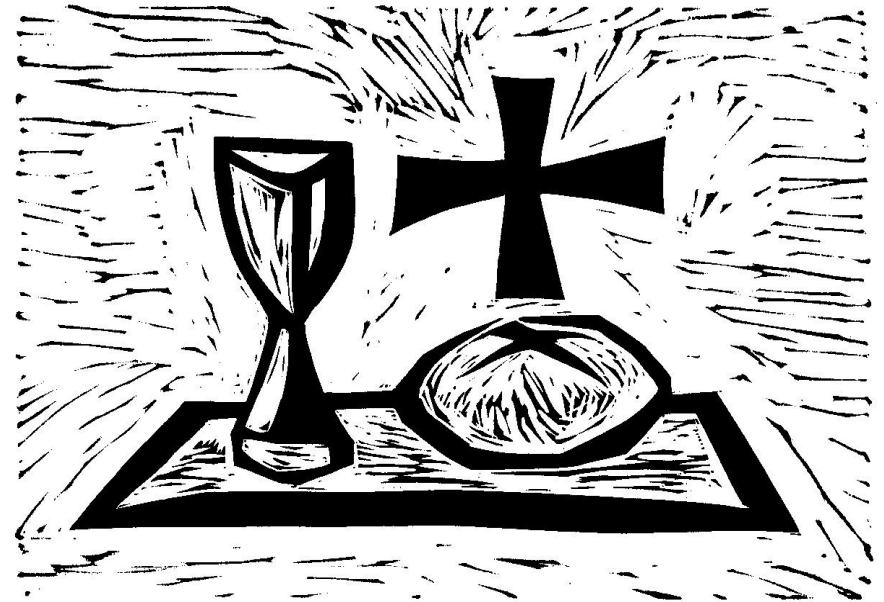
