Missions

 - 1. **Donate food items**. We are always in need of mac and cheese, juice boxes, granola bars, cereal bars, pop tarts, applesauce, pudding cups, and fruit cups. Please leave your donation in the Food Pantry Room (one of the small rooms accessible from the Howard Room).
 - 2. **Help us pack the bags** on the first and third Wednesdays of the month at 5:30 pm in the Howard Room.
 - 3. **Help us deliver bags.** Meet at the church on the first and third Thursdays of each month at 8:30 am.

These are meaningful ways to show children and parents in our community that First Baptist cares about them.

- Weekly Mission Project at Piedmont Emergency Relief Center (PERC) - Help us pack and distribute food bags/boxes to neighbors in need each Thursday afternoon at PERC (3 Main Street - Piedmont). Preparation begins around 2:30, and distribution is between 4 and 6 pm. Come when you can and stay as long as you can.


