"The Strength of Our Faith Builds Our Togetherness in Christ"

As we seek His face and do the will of God during our Summer Sermon Series in Galatians, Ephesians, and Philippians, let us be mindful of how we can demonstrate what it truly means to be "together in Christ."

Paul's letter to the Galatians strengthens our faith and assurance that we are truly free in Christ ("It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery," Galatians 5:1, NIV). His letter to the Ephesians strengthens our faith and gives us understanding about the true nature and purpose of the Church ("There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all," Ephesians 4:4-6, NIV). And, his Epistle to the Philippians strengthens our faith and offers us the only true source of joy through Jesus Christ ("Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice! Philippians 4:4, NIV). We have freedom, purpose, and joy in and through Christ alone. But, with such freedom, purpose, and joy comes the responsibility to do the Lord's will. It is God's will that these Divine strengths are to be invested in the building up of the Church, the Body of Christ, and in furthering His Kingdom.

With singleness-of-mind and purpose, are we using the strength of all our gifts, talents, time, and treasures in proclaiming the Gospel to the lost in our community, in the making and multiplying of maturing disciples, and in serving others as Jesus serves us each day? Or, are we selfishly and neglectfully simply giving back to God out of our excess, our leftovers, and our scraps – if there are any crumbs left to spare?

God's Master Plan includes the desire to set us free, to give us joy, and the building up of our faith in order for our Church to live and work "together in Christ." But, this can only be achieved if we are truly filled and walking in the authority and power of the Holy Spirit; in our mind, body, heart, soul, spirit, attitude, and behavior.

Together, let us allow God to use us to encourage and strengthen one another's faith and the building up of the Saints until His return. Let us work together in completing the mission the Lord has given to us, individually and as "One in Christ Jesus" (Galatians 3:28). This is how we truly demonstrate thanks to God for what He has done for each of us.


