A MESSAGE FROM REV. RONALD DEAN RALLIS, SR.
"Set Your GPS Destination for the Good Soil on Your Road of Life"

The transmission gearshift of your passenger vehicle has four basic operating positions — "*P-R-N-D*" (Park, Reverse, Neutral, and Drive or more commonly referred to as Stopped, Backwards, Free-Rolling, and Forwards). I think a "gearshifter" analogy could be made to the Parable of the Four Soils (Matthew 13:1-23; Mark 4:1-20; Luke 8:4-15). Sitting in the driver's seat, you have the control to make your car respond and go anywhere you choose. When we hear the Word of God ("the Seed," Mark 4:14), God has given us the freewill to choose how we will respond as one of four soils.

On our road of life, we can remain in "Park" on the path, resulting in a failure to listen and stopped from receiving God's Word. If we engage the "Reverse" setting while driving on the rocky soil, when trouble or persecution come along, we become resistant, making a quick backward exit as fairweather Christians. Sitting in "Neutral" gear is like your car is free-rolling amongst the worries, greed, and worldly desires offered on the thorny ground. Remaining in neutral because you do not want to "give up the world to gain Christ," you cannot bear any spiritual fruit. But, if we set our GPS destination for the good soil, when we intentionally place our gear in "Drive" as we go forward and accept God's Word and give up everything for Christ, our lives will bear much fruit.

For drivers on their road of life who want to grow and be true disciples of Christ, "Park-Reverse-Neutral" are not options. Only those who operate in "Drive" and choose to be the good soil are receptive to Jesus and obey His commands; for Jesus declared, "...whoever of you does not renounce all that he has cannot be my disciple" (Luke 14:33).

Matthew 6:28 & 30 "See how the lilies of the field grow. They do not labor or spin...If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and gone tomorrow, will he not much more clothe and care for you—you of little faith?"

May we all DRIVE to nourish our faith in Christ
