

### **RECOMMENDATION FROM THE DEACONS**

The Deacons recommend that the funds from the sale of the parsonage in April of 2004 (\$134,773.30), and designated for a Family Life Center, be redesignated as unrestricted funds to be used in the future as the church deems appropriate.
